Dear Parents/Guardians

In the event of a positive COVID- 19 case involving a member of the school community, Contact Tracing may issue instructions to the school only if action needs be taken by the school, staff, students and parents.

Contact Tracing

Contact tracing identifies people who were in <u>close contact</u> with someone who has COVID-19 (coronavirus).

It is done to try to reduce the spread of COVID-19 in the community. The people who do this work are 'contact tracers'. Contact tracers may contact you if your daughter:

- tests positive for COVID-19
- is a close contact of someone who has tested positive

If your daughter is a close contact they will advise her to restrict her movements for 14 days. They will also arrange for her to get tested.

If your daughter has COVID-19 symptoms

If your daughter tests positive

If your daughter tests positive for COVID-19 a contact tracer will call you. They will ask for contact details for any of her close contacts, particularly those in the 48 hours prior to the onset of symptoms.

If your daughter tests positive and has symptoms

They will ask about people and places your daughter has visited 48 hours before her symptoms started and until she started self-isolating.

If your daughter tests positive but does not have symptoms

They will only ask about people and places she has visited 24 hours before her test took place and until she started self-isolating. There is practically no risk in passing on the virus, especially if she is practicing social distancing.

If your daughter is a close contact

If your daughter is a close contact of someone who has tested positive you will receive a call from a contact tracer. Your daughter will have to:

- get tested for COVID-19
- restrict her movements for 14 days even if your daughter's test comes back negative

A contact tracer will arrange a COVID-19 test even if your daughter do not have symptoms.

She may be referred for 2 tests if she is a close contact. The first test will be straight away. The second test will be around 7 days after her last contact with the person who tested positive.
