This book is about a teenage boy who goes through adolescent years while also going through his own struggles and obstacles



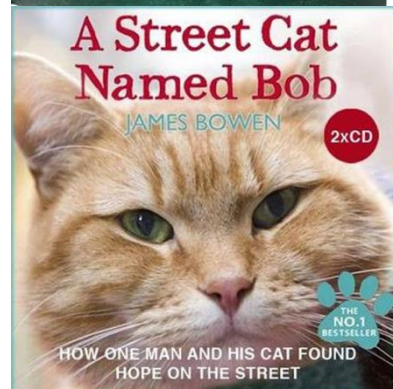
In a Dark Dark Wood by Ruth Ware

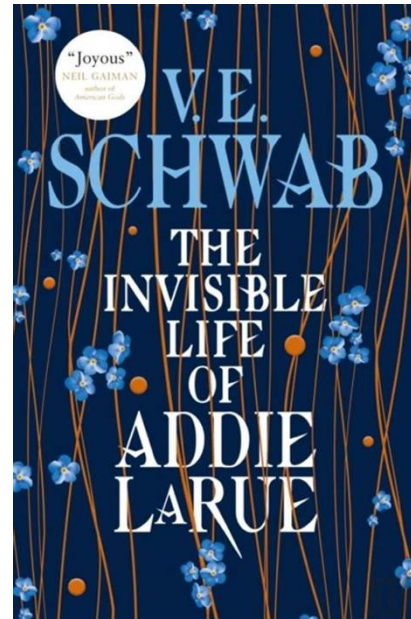
A Street Cat Named Bob by James Bowen

A stray ginger cat changes the life of James Bowen a homeless London street musician and recovering drug addict.



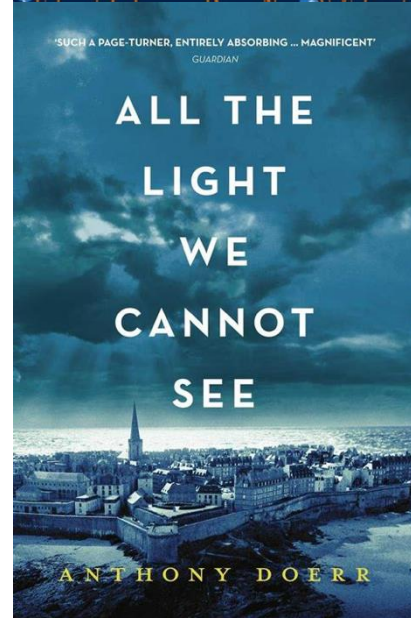
The Invisible Life of Addie LaRue by V.E Schwab

This is the book I am finishing and recommend. It is about a young woman who trades her soul for immortality but is cursed to be forgotten by everyone one she meets.



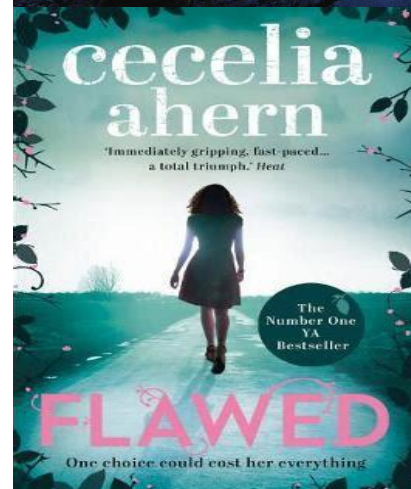
All the Light We Cannot See by Anthony Doerr

This book tells the story of two teenagers during World War II, one a blind girl in Nazi-occupied France, the other a German orphan boy pressed into service by the Nazi army.



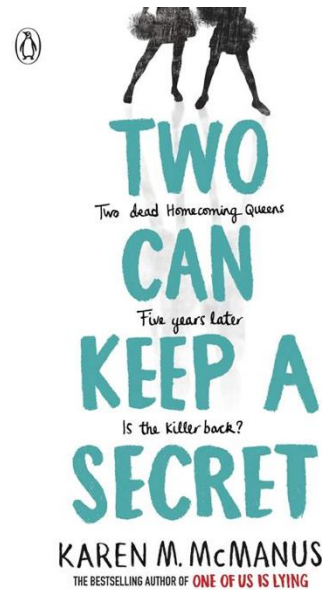
Flawed by Cecelia Ahern

"Flawed" is about how society demands that people be perfect but the main character breaks the rules and has other ideas.



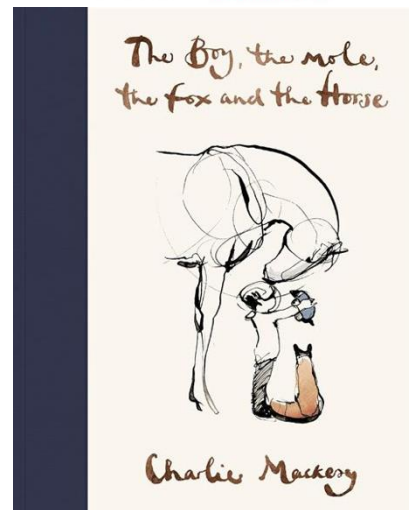
Two can keep a Secret

The story is about a teenage girl whose aunt goes missing. When the teenager moves to her Gran's house she starts to get death threats...



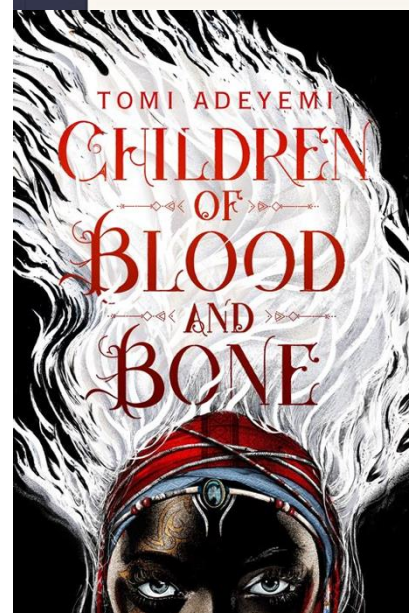
The Boy, the Mole, the Fox and the Horse

This is a book about self love and self kindness , friendship , reaching out for help, speaking your mind, being grateful for what you have, being enough how you are.



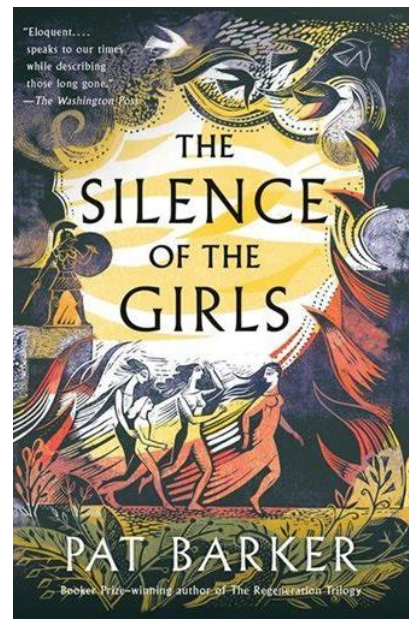
Children of Blood and Bone

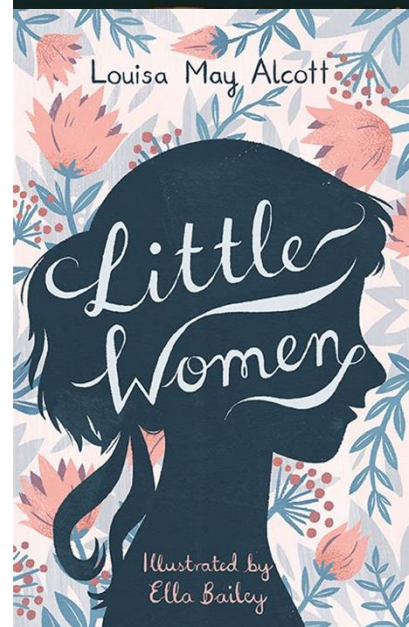
**The Silence of

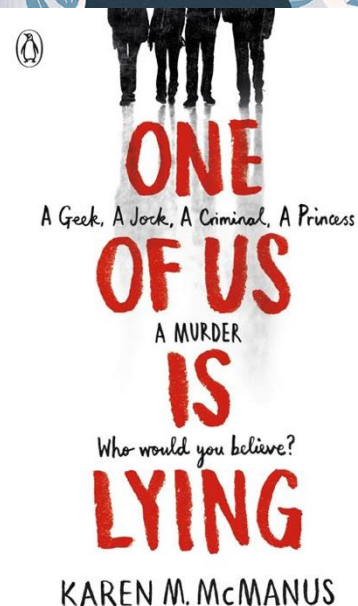
**Little Women by

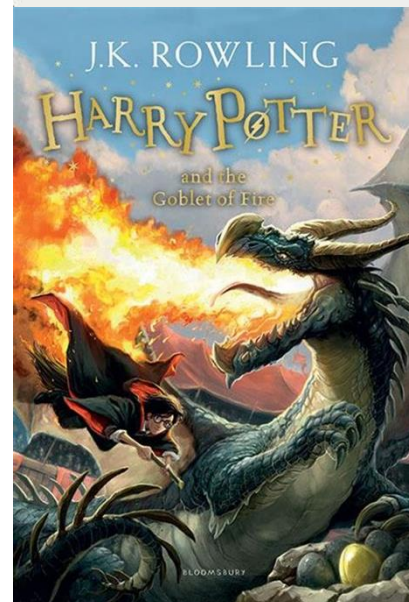

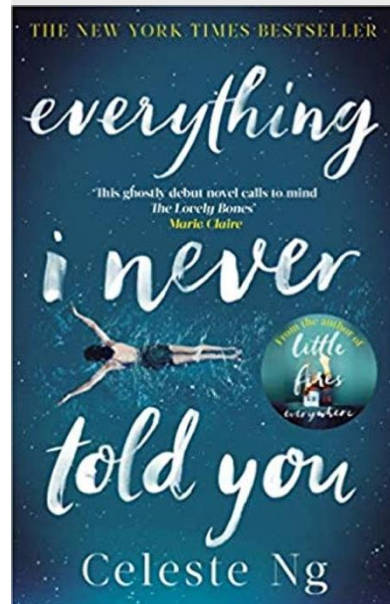
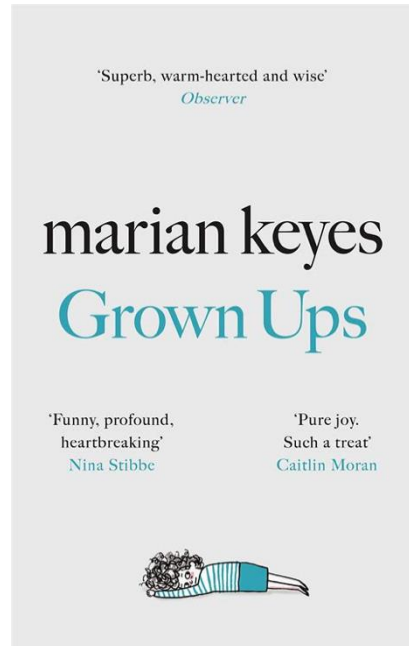


Grown Ups by Marian Keys

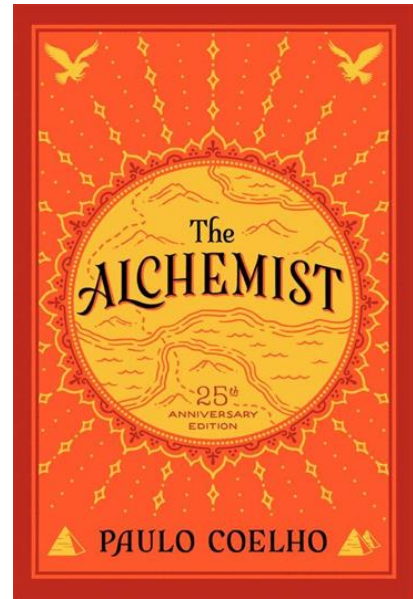
Everything I Never Told You by Celeste Ng

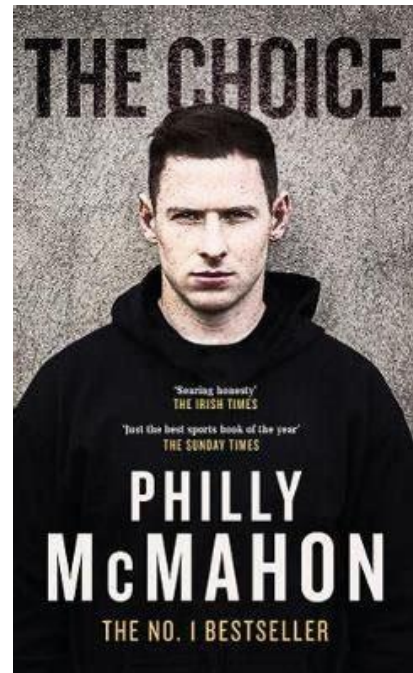

A Good Girl's Guide To Murder by Holly Jackson

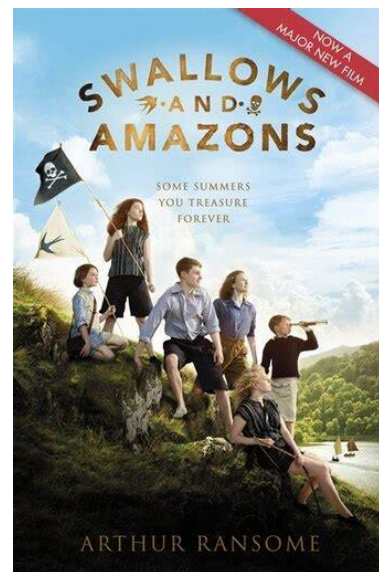
