OUTLINE OF INVESTIGATIONS PERFORMED

Investigations are carried out by qualified technicians and physicians. Blood samples are taken by qualified experienced phlebotomists. All procedures and tests are performed in-house.

- Full Blood Count
- Kidney Function Tests
- Bone Profile
- Liver Function Tests
- Total Lipid Profile (Cholesterol, LDL & HDL Cholesterol Levels)
- Fasting Blood Sugar (Diabetes Screen)

- **PSA** (Prostate Cancer Screen, Males Age 40+)
- TSH (Thyroid Function)
- Vitamin B12

OTHER TESTS

(Included as part of your assessment)

- Stool Analysis
- Urine Analysis (Diabetes, Infection, Kidney function)
- Electrocardiogram (Resting ECG tracing of the heart)
- Chest X-Ray (if clinically indicated)
- Cervical Smear (every 2 years) (If patient is not already taking part in the National Screening Programme)



ADDITIONAL TESTS, IF CLINICALLY INDICATED (additional charges apply)

Must be discussed at time of booking.

- Mammogram: A mammogram is a series of breast x-rays (available for women over 40 years)
- Dexa Scan: A bone density scan for the early detection of osteoporosis
- Stress ECG: Records the activity of the heart while exercising on a treadmill (recommended for men over 40 and women in their late 40's)
- Calcium Scoring: Screening used for the early detection of Coronary Heart Disease
- Vascular Screening: AAA, Carotid and PVD Screen

HOW TO FIND US

Located just a few minutes walk from O'Connell Street, Health Check at the Mater Private is easily accessible from the main rail, bus and luas stations. We are also close to the M50 and other main national routes.







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
