Business Studies	<p><u>Business in Action:</u> Group project based on one of three options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Enterprise in Action 2. Economics in Action 3. Finance in Action. <p>Presented as a group project with each student submitting an Individual Student Research Template and an Individual Student Reflection</p>
English	<p><u>Oral Communication:</u> There are two areas of activity to the assessment of Oral Communication: preparation and communication. In completing the Oral Communication CBA individually or in groups, students may use the following formats: performance, presentation, interview or response to stimulus material. Individual or group communication or presentation.</p>
History	<p><u>The Past in My Place:</u> Group, pair or individually students will identify and investigate sources of evidence on into a historical aspect or theme relating to the locality, place or personal/family history of the student. Students will present their research in the form of a display, of the type that they may encounter in a museum, heritage centre or library.</p>
Home Economics	<p><u>Creative Textiles:</u> Individual project. Make a creative textile item for an individual or the home or recycle/upcycle a creative textile for an individual or the home.</p>
Geography	<p><u>Geography in the news:</u> Structured inquiry through a response to a recent geographical event. Reports may be presented in a wide range of formats.</p>

MFL French + German (MFL)	<u>Oral Communication:</u> Students prepare and present a three minute oral communication in the target language. Individual, pair or group communication using an interview, role-play or presentation.
Music	<u>Composition Portfolio:</u> Students will compile a collection of their musical ideas and creative expressions in a variety of genres and styles over time. Two pieces will be chosen by the student from her portfolio and presented towards the end of second year. A student reflection is included with each piece.
Visual Art	<u>From process to Realisation:</u> Students chose to work from one of the given themes to develop their ideas for a final piece of work. They develop their ideas through a sketchbook, which is part of the CBA. Their work can be either a craft piece, a painting a poster or a piece of sculpture.
Classical Studies	<u>Storytelling using myth</u> In CBA 1, students will explore the purpose of myth as a form and medium of storytelling and will show the results of their exploration in a mode of their choice.
