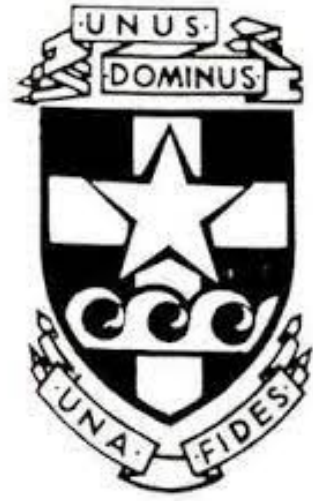

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- The SST meets weekly to discuss the needs of students. If there is a concern about the emotional wellbeing, behaviour, or learning needs of a student, it is discussed with the relevant year head and the rest of the team. The aim is to decide what action is needed to best support the student
- Students can be referred by teachers, parents or other students
- If it is necessary, as student can be referred to an outside agency
- Parents are kept informed throughout

CONFIDENTIALITY

Privacy is very important to us so all information remains confidential and is only discussed with the necessary parties, with the best interests of the students in mind.



WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE SST?

- The Student Support Team allows regular, formal meetings, between relevant staff, to make sure that the holistic needs of our students are being met.
- If a concern arises about a student, our aim is to make sure that these concerns are dealt with in a way that supports the student throughout, ensuring that whatever the issue may be has limited impact on their learning and wellbeing.
