Dear Parent & Student

I hope you and your family have had a good summer and that you are looking forward to returning to school. It will be great to have a return to school without any Covid restrictions and a full return to all co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

We have completed the refurbishment of the Transition Year corridor and have upgraded the Computer Room with a view to introducing Computer Science as a Leaving Certificate subject in 2023. In the meantime we will have our first group of students starting Leaving Certificate Physical Education in September. We will have an information sessions with students on 1st September about our new lunch service for students and staff, with a start date of 5th September.

A reminder to students that all are required to wear full school uniform and follow all uniform guidelines on returning to school.
